



INFORMATION FOR GUESTS

Welcome to Blue Moon! We spent a lot of time selecting and outfitting this Lagoon 52F and hope you'll enjoy her as much as we do. To maximize your safety and enjoyment, please take a minute to read the following information.

Introduction	All boats have rules but we've tried to keep them to a minimum so you can focus on relaxing and having fun. We want to return your entire security deposit at the end of the cruise – please help us to do that by treating Blue Moon and her crew as you would like a guest to treat your boat and crew.
Captain	Our captain's first priority is to ensure you and Blue Moon are safe. His second priority is to make sure you have fun. Please obey all of his instructions.
Hostess	Our hostess' first priority is to make sure you have nice food and drinks on board. Her second priority is to make up the rooms and keep the boat clean during your charter. Please understand this is a big job. If you plan to have 8-10 guests on board and plan to eat all your meals aboard you may want to consider a third crew member to help. Please speak to us about this.
Smoking	Absolutely no smoking inside Blue Moon. If you must smoke then please do so at the stern of the boat and collect your cigarette butts for safe disposal. Note the comment about cushions below.
Shoes	Please no shoes on the boat or the dinghy.
Red Wine	Many boats do not allow red wine because it can stain the cushions, tables and even the gelcoat of the boat. We, however, understand the need for red wine so go ahead and enjoy but please be careful and understand that you will be responsible for any stains that we cannot remove.
Dinghy	Please allow our captain to drive the dinghy.
Cushions	Unlike most charter boats in Phuket, we have left the original high-quality Sunbrella cushions on board for you to enjoy. Note that that stained, burned, damaged or lost cushions will need to be replaced at your cost and they are quite expensive so please be careful.
